Attendees receive a formal presentation regarding the threats against information, the scope of the information theft problem and information security breaches that can occur in both the office and out of the office environments. Examples from case studies and films are used to analyse the implications of events and the lessons learned for today's challenges.

As an executive you are the individual in charge and ultimately responsible for your department or business unit's well-being. You are the primary sponsor and implementer of the information security programme. Overall you are the one that needs to understand and grasp the concepts of this important topic. This briefing will inform

you of your role and responsibilities and how to ensure the implementation of a sound policy, procedures and guidelines for your department.

The future will be much riskier than what it is today. Knowledge bases and information flows will be under threat from more sophisticated spies and fraudsters, who might not only aim to thrash them or steal them, but also manipulate the contents to their advantage.

Government executives need to look at information protection from a different perspective. People are referred to as "a company's greatest asset" but when it comes to information security, people are also a department's "greatest liability". A sound information protection plan or programme based on the MISS policy is necessary to meet new challenges, threats, technologies, exposures and the increasing business dependency on IT.
